PRINCE THOMAS OF SAVOY MEN'S SCHOLARSHIP

The Prince Thomas of Savoy Society has established a yearly scholarship to be awarded to a student whose **father**, **grandfather** or **great grandfather** is a member in good standing of the Prince Thomas of Savoy Society for at least two years. Awarding of this scholarship is primarily based on the need for financial assistance to pursue a course of study beyond the high school level. The same criteria apply to adopted or stepchildren and to children of recently deceased members who were in good standing for at least two years. **Both male and female students are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.**

Criteria by which a scholarship is awarded

A committee composed of members of the Prince Thomas of Savoy Society will review all applications. Only members of the committee that are not related to any of the applicants will be involved in the review process.

In their review, the committee will consider the financial need, based on estimated cost of the education, funds available and extenuating circumstances such as family income, number of siblings also attending college, loss of a job, illness etc. These factors will be given the highest priority. Other factors that will be given consideration include the applicant's effort to self-finance, academic achievement, record of community service, extracurricular activities and the presentation of the application. If there are more than three qualified applications a preference may be given to the first-time recipient.

The Prince Thomas of Savoy Society guarantees that a minimum of \$6,000 will be available for scholarships in any given year regardless of the amount of funds in the Scholarship account. It is anticipated that three scholarships of \$2,000 each will be awarded each year.

Criteria the applicant must meet in order to apply for a scholarship

The applicant must have received a high school diploma or must be scheduled to receive one in the current school year.

The applicant must have been accepted to or be currently enrolled in a college, community college or an institution that offers a technical or other training program for a minimum of two years.

General information for the applicant

The Scholarship recipient will be notified by the third Friday in May. The scholarship award will be sent directly to recipient.

The recipient will be invited along with his/her parents as guests of the Scholarship Committee to the Sunday Brunch at which time the scholarship will be presented.

The completed application including grade transcripts and letters of reference must be submitted and received by April 30th via email address below:

Incomplete applications or applications submitted after April 30th will not be accepted. The Scholarship Committee has the option to revoke the Scholarship if any information in the application is found to be misleading, false or unfulfilled after the Scholarship has been awarded.

The scholarship application can be download from our website(www.ptsavoy.com). Under the home heading click on applications and scroll down to the Men's scholarship application. This is a fillable pdf so information can be added directly to this form.

In addition to the information in the application, please provide the following documents:

- 1. A transcript of all grades from the high school or from the college most recently attended. A copy of transcripts will be sufficient for the initial application process; however, official transcripts may be required upon request.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation focusing on work ethic and scholarship. (Letters may be included with the application or their advisor may email them to: Ptsavoy1917@gmail.com with the subject line Mens scholarship).
- 3. A single-spaced typewritten essay no more than one page stating the reasons why you should be considered for the Scholarship. Keep in mind that this is a need-based scholarship.
- 4. A brief financial statement is also part of this application form.

The committee respects and protects the privacy of all information submitted. No information will be shared outside of the committee and copies of all applications will be destroyed once the scholarship is awarded.
